



KM Cap

This cap was designed by Bridget Dean (www.haveyouanywoolmi.com) and Joan Sheridan (www.heritagespinning.com) in support of a promotional opportunity for Knit Michigan at Detroit's FOX 2. To learn more about Knit Michigan visit: www.knitmichigan.com.

Materials: One ball Grande by Schulana, US 15 (10 mm), 16" (40 cm) circular needles and/or double points. To substitute compare to ball band: 9 stitches and 13 rows in 4" using US Size 15 (10 mm) needles.

Knitting Instructions:

Cast on 36 stitches and join for working in the round.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: Purl

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 two more times for a total of 6 rounds. Switch to stockinette stitch (knit every round) and knit until hat measures approximately 6 inches or 22 rounds. Switch to double pointed needles and begin decrease section.

Round 22: K2tog, k7 around

Round 23: K2tog, k6 around

Round 24: K2tog, k5 around

Continue in this manner knitting one stitch less between decreases every round until there are 8 stitches remaining. Draw yarn through remaining 8 stitches and weave in ends.
