



Offset Rib Chemo Cap

Finished size: hat circumference (slightly stretched) approx. 16", but stretches to fit most.

Gauge: 38 sts and 44 rows to 4" over k2, p2 rib using U.S. #3 needles

Materials:

260 yds of sock weight yarn (sample used less than 1 skein Lana Grossa Meilenweit Cotton)

16" circular U.S. #3 needle

U.S. #3 double-pointed needles

1 stitch marker

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

Rnd – round

K2tog – knit 2 sts together

P2tog – purl 2 sts together

sts – stitches

Knitting Instructions

Using circular needle, cast on 160 sts. Join in rnd, placing st marker to mark beginning of rnd.

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Repeat Rnd 1 until piece measures 2 1/2" from cast-on edge.

Next Rnd: *P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Repeat last rnd until piece measures 6 1/2" from cast-on edge.

Switch to double-pointed needles for crown of hat.

Crown:

Rnd 1: *P2tog, k2tog; rep from * to end. (80 sts)

Rnds 2-8: *P1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: *P1, k3tog; rep from * to end. (40 sts)

Rnds 10-16: *P1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 17: *K2tog; rep from * to end. (20 sts)

Rnd 18: *K2tog; rep from * to end. (10 sts)

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Thread tail through remaining 10 sts and draw tightly closed. Weave in ends.
